SUBJECT: VARIANCE NO. 1767 / PLOT PLAN NO. 20201 – EA40005 – Applicant: Norman F. Busch – Engineer / Representative: Synergy Development Services, LLC - First Supervisorial District – Sedco-Wildomar Zoning Area – Elsinore Area Plan: Community Development: Very Low Density Residential (CD-VLDR) (1 Acre Minimum) – Location: Northerly of Bundy Canyon Road and Westerly of Harvest Way – 4.45 Gross Acres - Zoning: Mobilehome Subdivision and Mobilehome Parks (R-T) - **REQUEST:** The variance requests a facility height increase from 50 feet (the allowed maximum facility height in the R-T zone) to 75 feet to ensure maximum signal propagation. The plot plan proposes to install a 75 foot monopine with twelve antennas, one microwave dish and two GPS antennas, with an equipment shelter within a 1,144 square feet lease area of a 4.45 gross acre parcel.
