
SUBJECT: Recommendations From The Veterans' Advisory Committee (VAC) Regarding Membership

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

3. Reappoint Don Krampe, 40581 Via Amapola, Murrieta, CA 92562, (951) 600-0542, to a new 2-year term to expire June 30, 2008.

BACKGROUND: Mr. Mizak is an Air Force veteran, served in Vietnam, and was nominated for VAC membership by VFW Post 9223 (Riverside). He has been active in the VFW, the American Legion and the RNC Memorial Honor Detail.

Mr. Hagen is a Navy veteran, also served in Vietnam, and was nominated by AMVETS Post 66, Rancho Mirage, CA. He has been active in the Navy League and the AMVETS-Express transportation service, transporting veterans from the Coachella Valley to the Loma Linda VA Medical Center.

Mr. Krampe was originally appointed to the VAC as an at-large member in September of 2004. When his regular term expired on June 30, 2006, he indicated his desire to continue as a member of the VAC.

At the VAC's regular October 3rd meeting, the district representatives present voted to recommend to the Board of Supervisors that Mr. Mizak and Mr. Hagen be appointed to fill the two at-large vacancies and that Mr. Krampe be reappointed to a new 2-year term.
