**BACKGROUND:** Government Code Section 31010 allows for the creation of an advisory council within unincorporated territory for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on matters including, but not limited to, public health, safety, welfare, public works and planning.

**BACKGROUND continued:**

The Thousand Palms Community Council (District 4) was established under Resolution Number 90-107 by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on February 20, 1990. The minute order for Agenda Item 3.14 regarding Resolution Number 90-107 allowed for mileage reimbursement to compensate Thousand Palms Community Council members who are required to travel long distances to attend Board of Supervisors or Planning Commission meetings, as the costs were expected to be minimal. The Thousand Palms Community Council members have not sought mileage reimbursement.

The Pinyon Communities Council (District 3) was established under Resolution Number 92-206 by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on April 21, 1992. The minute order for Agenda Item 3.38 regarding Resolution Number 92-206 allowed for mileage reimbursement to compensate Pinyon Communities Council members who are required to travel long distances to attend Board of Supervisors or Planning Commission meetings, as the costs were expected to be minimal. The Pinyon Communities Council members have not sought mileage reimbursement.

The Sky Valley Community Council (District 4) was established under Resolution Number 93-109 by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on March 16, 1993. The minute order for Agenda Item 3.13 regarding Resolution Number 93-109 allowed for mileage reimbursement to compensate Sky Valley Community Council members who are required to travel long distances to attend required meetings, as the costs were expected to be minimal. The Sky Valley Community Council members have not sought mileage reimbursement.

The members of the other Community Councils and Municipal Advisory Councils of the County of Riverside are not authorized to receive any reimbursement or compensation for their expenses, nor are the members authorized to receive mileage reimbursement.

This action will bring the Pinyon Communities Council, Thousand Palms Community Council, and the Sky Valley Community Council in line with the other Community Councils and Municipal Advisory Councils of the County.
