**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign Agreement #06F-4796 between the State of California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD) and the Department of Public Social Services-Community Action Partnership of Riverside County (DPSS-CAP Riverside) to fund the 2006 Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan for Riverside County at risk, low-income households, not to exceed \$66,500; and
- 2) Authorize the Director of DPSS-CAP Riverside to sign assurances, exhibits, and reports required by the award.
- 3) Instruct the Auditor Controller to adjust the DPSS-CAP Riverside budget as follows:

## **BACKGROUND**

Since 2002, CSD has provided DPSS-CAP Riverside a total of \$420,000 in funding to support the agency's Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan for Riverside County. The Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan is a comprehensive response to the impact of extreme hot weather on low-income county residents, especially vulnerable seniors, with emphasis in the desert areas where temperatures often exceed 105° through October.

Again this year, DPSS-CAP Riverside submitted a Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan to CSD to request discretionary funding in support of the Plan. CSD approved this request and is making available \$66,500 in 2006 CSBG Discretionary funds to provide services for low-income households. The services to be provided would include:

- Support of Cool Centers throughout Riverside County. In 2002, DPSS-CAP Riverside implemented the innovative concept of a Cool Center, based on a model from Missouri. A Cool Center is a place (e.g. a senior center) that people can go to during the hottest part of the day to stay cool. Riverside County was the first county in California to implement this type of respite from the heat. The State has been overwhelmingly supportive and funded this component in 2002 through 2006.
- Distribution of flashlights and first aid/survival kits.

Therefore, the Director of DPSS-CAP Riverside requests the Board approve the Agreement between CSD and DPSS-CAP Riverside for the 2006 Summer Energy Crisis Response Plan, not to exceed \$66,500.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:** No County General Funds will be required.
