SUBJECT: Acceptance of a Grant Award from the Bureau of Justice Assistance of the U.S. Department of Justice, under the Gang Resistance Education and Training Program

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Accept a grant award in the amount of \$54,500 from the Bureau of Justice Assistance of the U.S. Department of Justice for the Gang Resistance Education and Training Program, and authorize the Chairperson to sign all copies of the grant award Agreement.
2. Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the budget adjustments on the attached Schedule A.

BACKGROUND: The Colorado River Station of the Riverside County Sheriff's Department has been awarded funds for the eighth year of a project aimed at preventing middle school students from gang involvement. The project, titled Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT), targets these students with information about the hazards of gang participation. The project also provides initial gang awareness training to students in the early elementary grades. The program involves law enforcement, parents, school personnel and the community. The project in Blythe will support a portion of the costs for the Deputy Sheriff who works with nearly 500 elementary and middle school students during the academic year. Funds also provide incentives for students, including field trips, and promotional items such as t-shirts, pencils and drinking cups.

The 2006 grant application process changed this year. The GREAT program grant awards have become discretionary (over the last few years only on-going projects were eligible for awards), and now require a local match. The Department will provide an in-kind local match of \$6,056 in Deputy salaries. All funds awarded must be spent prior to December 31, 2006.
