BACKGROUND: Portions of Rancho California Road were severely damaged during the 2004 / 2005 storm season, and repair of ten specific segments of the road is necessary.

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The Transportation Department has received authorization for FHWA funds for this project. The Department is seeking reimbursement from the State Office of Emergency Services for a minor portion of the project costs. By Minute Order dated May 9, 2006 (agenda item no. 3.26), the Board approved the Transportation Department's report and recommendations regarding the funding for various storm damaged roads, including Rancho California Road. After receipt of bids, the Department will prepare and submit a budget analysis and recommendations for the project.

The County's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) contains another project on Rancho California Road that is programmed for the purpose of providing improvements to the segments of Rancho California Road that are not included in this storm damage repair project.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel. Environmental clearance is complete.
