2. Authorize the Riverside County Waste Management Department (County) to advertise for bids for the Closure Construction at the Edom Hill Landfill.

*Departmental Concurrence*  
**BACKGROUND:** The County is required to perform closure construction in accordance with Federal Code of Regulations, Title 40 and California Code of Regulations, Title 27. In accordance with applicable regulations, the County has submitted a Final Closure and Post-Closure Maintenance Plan (FCPMP) to the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (CRWQCB), California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB), and Local Enforcement Agency (LEA). All three regulatory agencies have formally approved the FCPMP. The Contract Documents have been prepared in accordance with the requirements set forth in the FCPMP.
