BACKGROUND:

The Healthy Children Connection Program focuses on early entry into prenatal care and timely immunization of young children. This is a new grant for 36 months (3 years) from The California Wellness Foundation for the purpose of providing core operating support for Healthy Children Connection (HCC) to sustain the provision of nursing case management to at-least 300 unduplicated, at risk, pregnant women and mothers in the Coachella Valley. The program provides nursing case management through home visitation to families with pregnant women and mothers of children birth through the age of 5 years with identified needs, especially in the East Coachella Valley region. Statistics in 2000 showed the average rate of receiving prenatal care in the Coachella Valley was 73%, by 2004 prenatal care in the Coachella Valley rose to 87%; this is a dramatic increase of 14%. HCC has been a major contributing factor to the increased health in this region through building trust in the community through strategic partnerships with local organizations, promotoras for outreach, and the culturally sensitive and long-term approach of the PHN Nursing team to the needs of the families.

One of the key objectives of the Disease Control Branch is to educate and assist pregnant women and mothers of young children to prevent disease and promote health. HCC program has operated successfully for 5 years to achieve this objective.

This award overlaps with the County accounting year. The budget only can be adjusted for the portion applicable to FY06/07 which is in the amount of \$72,375.
