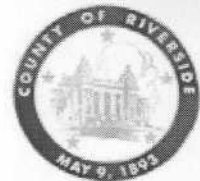

**SUBJECT:** Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for Grant Writing

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the hiring of a grant writer within the Economic Development Agency to assist non-profit agencies within the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Supervisorial Districts with fundraising; allocate \$62,500 in Fifth District Community Improvement Designation Funds for this purpose; and reduce the allocation of Second District Community Improvement Designation Funds from \$125,000 to \$62,500.

**BACKGROUND:** On September 26, 2006, item 3.76, the Board approved the hiring of a grant writer within the Economic Development Agency to assist non-profit agencies within the 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisorial District with fundraising and allocated \$125,000 in Second District Community Improvement Designation Funds for this purpose. The Fifth Supervisorial District is also in need of a grant writer for this purpose, and I have discussed with Supervisor Tavaglione the sharing of this position between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Districts. The recommended motion will approve the sharing of the grant writer between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Districts to be funded equally with \$62,500 each in Community Improvement Designation Funds. The funds were previously allocated in the Board Action on 9/26/06 so a budget adjustment is not necessary.
