BACKGROUND: Operation SafeHouse has been a haven for runaways and homeless youth in Riverside County since 1990. The program successfully counsels troubled teenagers to continue in school and help with family reunification. This organization has launched an effort to provide a shelter in the desert area of the County. Each year approximately 600 youth are provided with emergency shelter and this number will increase by providing additional services to the desert communities. I urge the Board to support additional funding for a new facility for the desert communities.
