SUBJECT: Acceptance of the FY 2006-07 Special Emphasis Grant Award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services and Adoption of Resolution 2006-433

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve acceptance of the Special Emphasis Grant ("SEG") grant award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services ("OES")
2. Adopt Resolution 2006-433 authorizing the District Attorney to submit a SEG grant application to OES and sign grant agreements on behalf of the Board through FY 2008-09. If funding of the grant significantly changes, is altered or discontinued, the department will return to the Board.

BACKGROUND: OES has renewed the SEG grant for the July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 grant period. This ongoing federally funded program is designed to provide culturally sensitive services directly to minority victims and secondary victims of felony assault, armed robbery, and homicide in the cities of Indio and Coachella through delivery of comprehensive services outlined in Penal Code sec. 13835.5. The grant award of \$110,000 and the \$27,500 required County match are included in the department's current fiscal year budget.

The grant award and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.



4 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
5 COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REGARDING
6 THE SPECIAL EMPHASIS GRANT ("SEG") PROGRAM

8 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside desires to undertake a certain program designated the
9 Special Emphasis Grant ("SEG") Program to be funded in part from funds made available through and
10 administered by the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (hereinafter referred to as "OES"); now,
11 therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,
13 State of California, in regular session assembled on November 28, 2006, that the Board of
14 Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby authorize the District Attorney of the County of
15 Riverside, State of California to submit and to sign Riverside County's application for grant funding as
16 well as related contracts, amendments, or extensions with OES.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County will provide the necessary 20% matching funds
18 required for the program.

19 IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil
20 court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency.
21 The State of California and OES disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period
23 beginning July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2009.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant
25 local expenditures controlled by this body.

26 IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to hiring freezes.
