SUBJECT: AGREEMENT WITH JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE OF SAN DIEGO TO PROVIDE COACHELLA VALLEY-SERVICES AND OVERNIGHT SHELTER (CV-SOS) SERVICES

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors ratify and:

- 1) Authorize the Chairman of the Board to sign the Agreement between Jewish Family Services of San Diego and the Department of Public Social Services (DPSS) for a lead provider to coordinate the Coachella Valley-Services and Overnight Shelter (CV-SOS) covering the term October 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007, not to exceed \$185,500;
- 2) Authorize the Purchasing Agent to sign ministerial amendments and the renewal contract with Jewish Family Service of San Diego for an additional one year not to exceed the full Fiscal Year amount of \$250,000; and
- 3) Authorize the Director of DPSS to administer the program.

SUBJECT: AGREEMENT WITH JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE OF SAN DIEGO TO PROVIDE COACHELLA VALLEY-SERVICES AND OVERNIGHT SHELTER (CV-SOS) SERVICES

BACKGROUND:

The Overnight Services Program provides seamless service to homeless individuals who cannot access mainstream resources. Currently, a number of organizations are serving homeless individuals in the Coachella Valley because there are no available emergency beds. As a result, the homeless are left to their own devices to find shelter. This becomes of even greater concern during the hot summer months and the cold winter evenings.

On October 18, 2005 (Agenda #3.44) the Board authorized DPSS to enter into an agreement with Jewish Family Service of San Diego in the amount of \$250,000 for one year to provide homeless services through local faith-based organizations (FBOs). These non-profit or tax-exempt organizations serve as "Hosts" offering overnight and temporary overnight shelter on a rotating basis. Each organization serves as guest Host one night per week. Homeless individuals are transported to the host organization. Designated CV-SOS staff remains at the host organization with the homeless participants. As of August 2006, 12-13 participants were served nightly. Funding for the attached agreement is \$180,421 for the 9-month period. For the prior contract period, 56 participants were served by the CV-SOS. Due to the successful operation of the program by JFS, we are recommending that the contract be renewed through the end of this fiscal year.

The attached contract is retroactive because of extended contract negotiations between DPSS and Jewish Family Service of San Diego.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: The annual cost to the County for these services will be 100% County General Funds
