**SUBJECT:** Agreement between the County of Riverside, the City of Riverside and American Medical Response (AMR).

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the three-way Agreement between the County of Riverside, the City of Riverside and American Medical Response (AMR) effective September 1, 2006 through June 30, 2009;
- 2) Authorize the Chairperson to execute said Agreement on behalf of the County;
- 3) Direct the Clerk of the Board to file one executed original Agreement and return three originals to the Community Health Agency/Department of Public Health Contracts Administration Office for final processing.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** On March 30, 2004, the Board of Supervisors approved the County/AMR Master Emergency Ambulance Agreement. This Agreement encompassed seven of the County's 12 exclusive ambulance operating areas and 18 of 24 cities. The City of Riverside had a pre-existing franchise agreement with AMR and wishes to ensure it maintains its administrative rights (if any) under the EMS Act (Health and Safety Code 1797 et seq.).
