**SUBJECT:** Acceptance of the FY 2006-07 Vertical Prosecution Block Grant Award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services and Adoption of Resolution 2006-434 and Resolution No. 440- 8700.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** Move that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve acceptance of the Vertical Prosecution Block ("VB") grant award from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services ("OES")
2. Adopt Resolution 2006-434 authorizing the District Attorney to submit applications to OES and sign agreements on behalf of the Board through FY 2008-09. If funding of the grant significantly changes, is altered or discontinued, the department will return to the Board.
3. Amend Ordinance 440 Pursuant to Resolution 440-8700 submitted herewith. Per the Resolution add the following positions:





**BACKGROUND:**

The Office of Emergency Services has renewed the VB grant for the July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 grant period. Increased funding allowed the addition of the Child Abuse component. A Deputy District Attorney IV and Senior DA Investigator position will be funded by the Child Abuse component.

Vertical prosecution involves the use of highly experienced and skilled prosecutors who prosecute a reduced caseload of specific types of serious criminal cases from the filing of the case through sentencing. The Career Criminal Prosecution (CCP) component of the VB program is designed to prosecute career criminals under arrest for the commission or attempted commission of one or more felonies and obtain the longest prison sentence possible as defined in Penal Code Sections 999b through 999g.

Increased state funding enabled the District Attorney to add the Child Abuse (CAVP) component of the VB program. The CAVP component is designed to concentrate prosecution efforts and resources upon individuals identified under criteria set forth in Penal Code 999t. Individuals are subject to prosecution under Penal Code 999t if he/she is charged with felony assault of a child under the age of 18 and is being prosecuted for one or more violations involving children (sexual abuse, child endangerment, assault resulting in the death of a child, etc.). The addition of a Deputy District Attorney IV and Senior DA Investigator will enable the District Attorney’s Office to expand and improve the effectiveness of Riverside County’s child abuse prosecution.

The grant award and resolution have been reviewed and approved as to form by County Counsel.

8 WHEREAS, the County of Riverside desires to undertake a certain program designated Vertical  
9 Prosecution Block ("VB") Program to be funded in part from funds made available through and  
10 administered by the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (hereinafter referred to as "OES"); now,  
11 therefore,

12 BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside,  
13 State of California, in regular session assembled on December 5, 2006, that the Board of  
14 Supervisors of the County of Riverside does hereby authorize the District Attorney of the County of  
15 Riverside, State of California to submit and to sign Riverside County's application for grant funding as  
16 well as related contracts, amendments, or extensions with OES.

17 IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil  
18 court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency.  
19 The State of California and OES disclaim responsibility for any such liability.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the resolution shall be in effect for a three-year period  
21 beginning July 1, 2006 and ending June 30, 2009.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant  
23 local expenditures controlled by this body.

24 IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to hiring freezes.
