SUBJECT: Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for Operation Troop Comfort operated by the Moreno Valley Chamber of Commerce Military Affairs Committee at March Air Reserve Base;
- 2) Approve and direct the Auditor-Controller to make the following budget adjustments:

BACKGROUND: Operation Troop Comfort has been in operation as a safe haven for troops deploying to and returning from Iraq and Afghanistan for four years. Each year approximately 55,000 service men and women come through March Air Reserve Base and are provided with sandwiches, beverages, snacks, phone cards, cots, blankets, pillows, games, internet service, stationary and stamps and have access to big screen televisions, pool tables and video games. This worthwhile project is supported entirely by community donations. I urge the Board of Supervisors to approve this use of Community Improvement Designation funds in support of our troops.
