**SUBJECT:** Indian Truck Trail/Interstate 15 Interchange Construction Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board approve and execute the attached Construction Cooperative Agreement between the County of Riverside and Caltrans for the Interchange Improvement project at Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15. (Caltrans Agreement No. 08-1294).

**BACKGROUND:**

The County has been working with the developer of Sycamore Creek on the improvement of the interchange at I-15/Indian Truck Trail, which is a requirement of that development. Since the cost of the improvement exceeds what the developer can do under a Caltrans encroachment permit, the County will be the lead agency for the construction phase, with funding to be provided by Sycamore Creek, other participating developers, and regional funding programs. The current schedule calls for the work to start in the Fall of 2007.

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The Construction Cooperative Agreement between Caltrans and the County of Riverside outlines each agency's responsibilities for the construction of the improvements at Indian Truck Trail and Interstate 15.

This agreement is necessary for Caltrans to provide project oversight, quality assurance, including appropriate reviews and approvals of submittals by the County, and to cooperate in timely processing of the project. The cost of project oversight and quality assurance will be borne by the State.

Through a separate agreement that is being prepared between the developer and the County, the funding agreements for the interchange improvements will be established.
