RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors formally approve the appointment of Eric K. Frykman, M.D., as Community Health Agency Director/Public Health Officer effective February 12, 2007.

BACKGROUND: The Human Resources Department along with the advisory services of Roberts Consulting Group, Inc., conducted a nationwide recruitment search to replace Dr. Gary Feldman, CHA Director/Public Health Officer. A preliminary review of applicants whose qualifications were most relevant to the position was completed. Of those, four (4) candidates were referred to the Board of Supervisors for final consideration. Dr. Frykman was offered the position, subject to Board approval.

BACKGROUND continued

Dr. Frykman is the Interim Public Health Director/Public Health Officer and Chief Public Health Medical Officer for the San Bernardino County Department of Public Health. In that capacity he supervises more than 1,000 workers and oversees an annual operating budget exceeding \$100 million.

Dr. Frykman obtained his Bachelor of Science degree in Bio-Chemistry from Loma Linda University Medical Center in 1992; Doctor of Medicine degree from Loma Linda in 1996; Master's degree in Public Health with an emphasis in international health in 1999 from Loma Linda; and a Master's degree in Business Administration from Claremont Graduate University in 2004.

Dr. Frykman is Board certified in Public Health and general preventive medicine by the American Board of Preventive Medicine.

Since 2003, Dr. Frykman also has been an Assistant Clinical Professor at the Loma Linda University Schools of Medicine and Public Health.

By your action today you will appoint Dr. Frykman to fulfill the County's obligations pursuant to Government Code Section 33200 et. seq. Dr. Frykman's salary will be \$200,018 annually.
