**SUBJECT:** Larry Smith Correctional Facility Subvention Agreement

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board approve a general fund subvention to the City of Banning of \$450,000 annually, with a cost of living adjustment (COLA) not to exceed 4% each year, for public safety mitigation.


**BACKGROUND:**

The Smith Correctional Facility in Banning is proposed for expansion. The existing facility capacity of 934 inmate beds may be expanded by a range of 400-600 beds. As the Board is aware, the Sheriff's Department has a significant custody deficit countywide, and this expansion is critical to maintaining public safety. We have discussed this public safety expansion with the City of Banning.

In recognition of this, we recommend providing a subvention to the City of Banning for public safety purposes, as follows:

- General Fund Subvention of \$450,000 annually with a COLA not to exceed 4% each year. The allocation will begin with a \$150,000 installment when an agreement is signed, \$150,000 six months following the signing of the agreement, and \$150,000 12 months after the signing of the agreement. Thereafter, the subvention will be paid annually on the anniversary date of project notice of completion.
- Implementation of a reverse 9-1-1 system for community notification of emergencies. This project is currently in development between the Sheriff's Department and the County Information Technology.
- Review of Sheriff's policies regarding visitation hours and inmate release locations.

Although a nexus study can be pursued to evaluate the measurable impacts of such development at the Smith Correctional Facility, these offsets demonstrate the County's willingness to work collaboratively with the City and provide for the safety of residents throughout the County of Riverside.
