SUBJECT: Approve the First 5 Riverside Agreement 07-20 OP between Riverside County Children and Families Commission and the Department of Public Health, Community Health Agency Nutrition Services Branch.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County Community Health Agency Department of Public Health Nutrition Services Branch received six months continued funding from Riverside County Children and Families Commission (RCCFC) in the amount of \$380,765. With these funds the Women, Infants and Children Supplemental Nutrition Program will:

- a) Provide nutrition assessments, education and food instrument vouchers to 1500 program participants at WIC sites located in the communities of Perris (Rob Reiner Resource Center), Riverside (Arlanza), Palm Desert and Mecca.
- b) Provide program participants with linkage to health care services via referrals to CHDP clinics, Comprehensive Perinatal Services program, immunization clinics and other community resources.

This Agreement has been approved as to form by County Counsel.
