RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors approves and:

1. Authorizes the Chairman of the Board to sign the attached renewal Grant Agreement between DPSS and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to continue the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 not to exceed \$260,498; and
2. Authorizes the Director of DPSS to administer the HMIS program with homeless service providers.

SUBJECT: HOMELESS MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM HOUSING
AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT RENEWAL GRANT AGREEMENT -
RIVERSIDE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SOCIAL SERVICES

BACKGROUND:

On July 14, 2004, the Board entered into a Supportive Housing Program grant agreement with HUD to implement the Homeless Management Information System, which is operated by DPSS for Riverside County. This web-based HMIS system allows the County to more effectively assess homeless needs, allocate resources, and coordinate services through its enhanced tracking and reporting capabilities.

On June 7, 2005, through the 2005 Continuum of Care Consolidated Application to HUD, the Board requested funding to support a 1-year renewal grant to continue to operate the HMIS throughout Riverside County.

HUD executed the attached Grant Agreement on May 9, 2006, which we are forwarding to your Board for approval.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The County's financial requirement is a 25% cash match (\$62,023) for HMIS funding only. There is no match requirement for Administration.
