
SUBJECT: TUMF Funding Agreement between the County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) and the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) for Van Buren Boulevard Widening from Washington Street to Wood Road (RCTC Agreement No. 06-72-047-00)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the attached TUMF Funding Agreement between the County of Riverside and RCTC, and authorize the Chairman to execute same.

BACKGROUND: This project consists of preparing the project development work and design work for the widening of Van Buren Boulevard from 4 to 6 lanes between Washington Street and Wood Road. Van Buren Boulevard serves Western Riverside County as a major regional facility. The County General Plan designates Van Buren Boulevard as a 6-lane Expressway from SR60 to I-215.

By this Agreement, RCTC intends to distribute \$790,000 TUMF Regional Funds to the County for the subject project, which includes preliminary engineering, environmental studies and environmental documentation, and preparation of the Plans, Specifications and Estimates.
