BACKGROUND Twin Pine Ranch is a Probation Department facility located in the San Jacinto Mountains eleven miles south of Banning. Youthful offenders, ages 15-18 years, receive academic, vocational, and life skills training at the Ranch during a ten month program. These funds, coupled with money raised by the Blue Knights Law Enforcement Motorcycle Club, will expand vocational training to include the automotive repair and enhance employability of graduates.
