SUBJECT: Joint Use Agreement with Corona Norco Unified School District for the Operation of a Joint Use Library at Eleanor Roosevelt High School.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to sign, the attached Joint Use Agreement with Corona Norco Unified School District at Roosevelt High School in Eastvale.

BACKGROUND: This Agreement with Corona Norco Unified School District will enable the County Library to operate a public library at Eleanor Roosevelt High School in a library facility that will be jointly used with the school. This will initiate public library service in the Eastvale Community. The library will be open to the public afternoons, evenings and Saturdays, 20 hours per week (Attachment A). The public portion of the library will commence operation January 15, 2007.

The County Library and the District will each provide its own staff that will be cross-trained to serve both the public and students. The District will provide the facility and most of the furniture and equipment. The County Library agrees to provide readers' tables and chairs, five public access computer catalogs, and a street-side bookdrop, to be utilized by both school and public library users. The County Library will also provide the District with access to the County Library automated computer system. The County Library will pay the District \$1,250 per month for use of the facility, which includes maintenance, custodial services, and utilities.

Operational costs are included in the 2006-07 contract with Library Systems and Services (LSSI) for operation of the County Library System. The Western County Book Fund will provide \$200,000 for an initial joint use collection, to be used by both students and the public.
