SUBJECT: County Service Areas 104 (Sky Valley) and 105 (Indio Hills) Road Improvement Projects

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the construction documents for the CSA 104/105 Chip Seal and Paving Project, the CSA 104 Grading Project, and the CSA 104 Magnesium Chloride Application Project; and
2. Authorize the Economic Development Agency to advertise the Notice Inviting Bids for the three projects.

BACKGROUND:

County Service Areas 104 and 105 are two County-administered special districts that provide road maintenance and improvements to non-County Transportation Department maintained roads. The proposed projects include approximately 3.3 miles of chip sealing (CSA 104) and 2 miles of asphalt paving (CSA 105), as well as approximately 20 miles of grading, dragging, rock dust application, and *Magnesium chloride* (dust suppressant) application throughout CSA 104. The above-described work includes both routine maintenance items and long-term improvements.

BACKGROUND (continued):

Due to increasing construction cost, as well as expanded size and scope of these projects, the anticipated cost is approximately \$800,000. The County will seek reimbursement from FEMA for portions of the work in CSA 104 located within areas severely damaged during recent storm events.
