**BACKGROUND:**

Pursuant to Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinley Homeless Act of 1987 (Public Law 100-77), the City of Riverside has been awarded Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) funds for the operation and maintenance of emergency shelter facilities. In accordance with program requirements, the City of Riverside would provide to DPSS funding in the amount of \$70,134 for the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 to defray part of the expenses of the emergency cold weather shelter operated by Path of Life Ministries.

Please note that the reason for the delay in bringing this to the Board is that the City usually provides the funding agreement to the County after the start of the fiscal year. The effective date of July 1, 2006 is the City of Riverside's traditional start date for all of their funding agreements. This allows the County to charge any allowable expenses incurred since July 1, 2006

The Board previously approved similar City of Riverside ESG agreements on March 28, 2006 (#3.9) and May 17, 2005 (#3.18).

**FINANCIAL DATA:**

Funds for operating the shelters have been included in the fiscal year 2006-07 budget.
