RECOMMENDED MOTION:

Approve the Cooperative Agreement between the District, the County of Riverside Transportation Department (Transportation), Pulte Home Corporation and SC Eastvale Development Corporation (Developers); and authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the District.

BACKGROUND:

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which certain flood control facilities, required as a condition for approval of Tract No. 30971, are to be constructed by the Developers and inspected, operated and maintained by the District and Transportation. The Agreement is necessary to formalize the transfer of necessary rights of way and to provide for District construction inspection and maintenance of the referenced drainage facilities associated with Tract No. 30971.

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BACKGROUND:

Upon completion of construction, the District will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the flood control facilities. Transportation will assume ownership, operation and maintenance of the associated catch basins, connector pipes and laterals located within its rights of way. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to legal form and the Developers has executed the Agreement. This matter is also on the County's Board Agenda (Transportation) for approval this same date.

The Developers are funding all construction and construction inspection costs. Future operation and maintenance costs will accrue to the District.
