

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the use of general fund monies in the amount of \$20,000, to create a reward for the apprehension and conviction of a man who recently tried to abduct, on several occasions, young girls walking home from school or at bus stops in the Third District communities of Hemet and San Jacinto and the Fifth District communities of Romoland and Homeland.

The creation of this reward may encourage the public to be aware of these activities and may generate more leads and information in the case. The use of general fund monies qualifies as a public benefit need.
