**SUBJECT:** Construction of Roadway Widening and Storm Drain Improvements, Valley Way and Armstrong Road, from State Highway 60 to Sierra Avenue, Sunnyslope / West Riverside area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the plans and specifications for the construction of roadway widening, storm drain and associated improvements on Valley Way and Armstrong Road, from State Highway 60 to Sierra Avenue, in the Sunnyslope / West Riverside area of Riverside County. Authorize the Clerk to advertise for bids to be received in the office of the Director of Transportation up to the hour of 2:00 pm, Wednesday, March 21, 2007 at which time bids will be opened.

**BACKGROUND:** The Transportation Improvement Program provides for the reconstruction and widening of Valley Way and Armstrong Road, from State Route 60 to Sierra Avenue. The improvements provide for roadway widening for the installation of four lanes of travel, and include the construction of a master plan storm drain system.

RE: Construction of Roadway Widening and Storm Drain Improvements, Valley Way and Armstrong Road, from State Highway 60 to Sierra Avenue, Sunnyslope / West Riverside area  
January 29, 2007

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The work is being coordinated with the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District and the County of Riverside Redevelopment Agency, which are each funding a portion of the work. The cooperative agreement with the Redevelopment Agency was approved on December 20, 2005 (Agenda items 3.22 and 4.4). The cooperative funding agreement with the Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District will be executed prior to submittal of the construction contract to the Board for award.

The project will provide necessary increased lane capacity on the project road, which is a major connector between the Riverside area and Fontana.

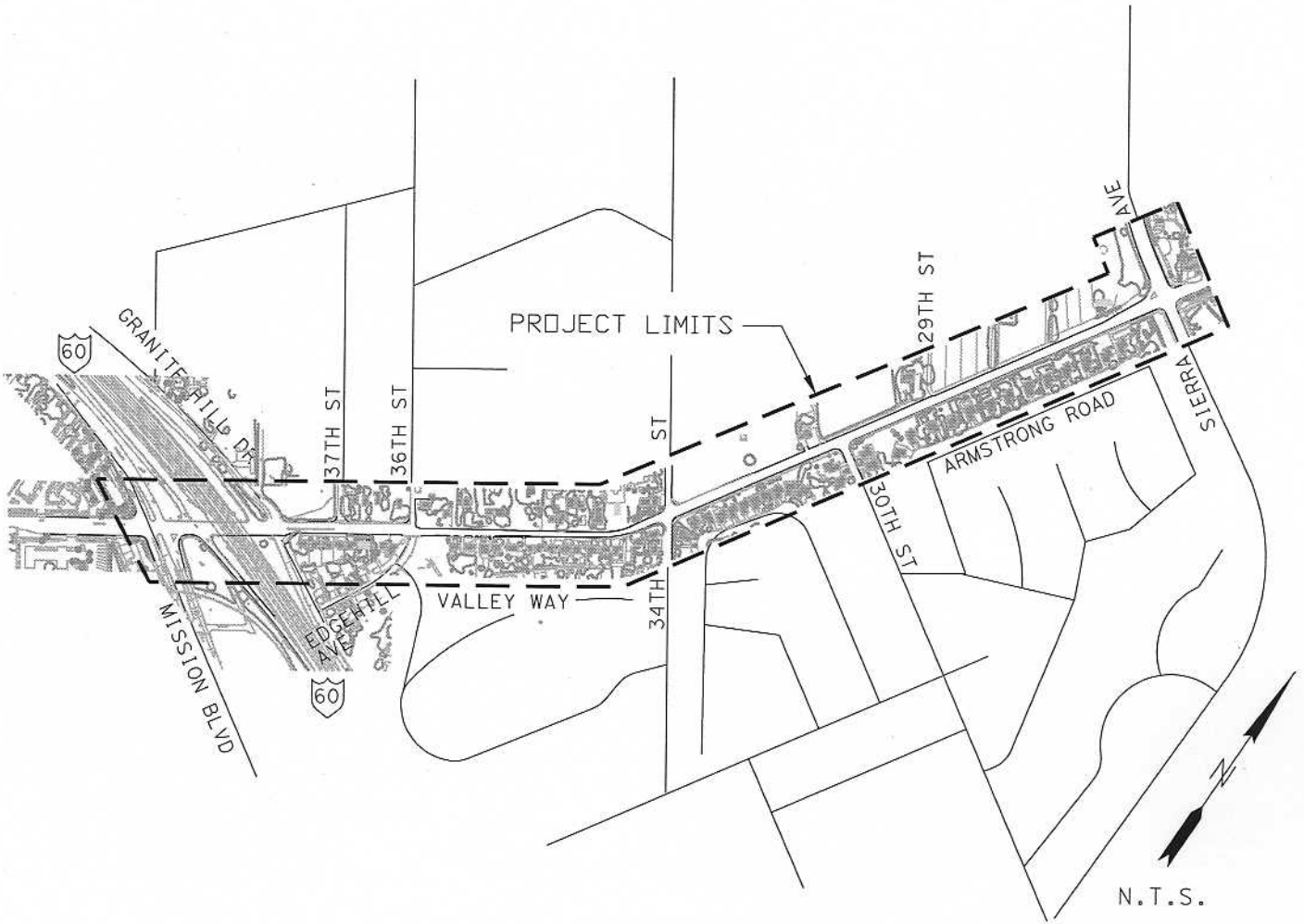
The relocation of a major transmission pole and tower system was a critical component of the project, and those relocations were unable to proceed until possession was secured on most of the necessary parcels. All right of way for the project has been acquired, and the Edison Company transmission pole relocation work is underway by the Edison Company and completion is anticipated prior to the start of work by the County's contractor.

A major waterline will be constructed by the Jurupa Community Services District during the construction of the County's improvements. Additionally, the adjustment to grade of utilities owned by the Jurupa Community Services District (JCSD) will be added to the bid package as an alternate bid schedule. If JCSD approves the award of the alternate bid schedule as bid by the apparent low bidder, the costs for the work will be funded by JCSD.

The Economic Development Agency has acquired the necessary rights of way for the project, which required the removal of homes and relocation assistance to the residents.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel. Environmental clearance is complete.
