The Board approved a contract with SCW Contracting Corporation, in the amount of \$1,115,096.36 as Agenda Item Number 11.14 on July 25, 2006. The District is in receipt of requests for additional compensation for additional work associated with construction changes required to meet existing field conditions. The total project cost is not expected to exceed \$1,142,000.00 including all the costs associated with the claims for additional compensation.

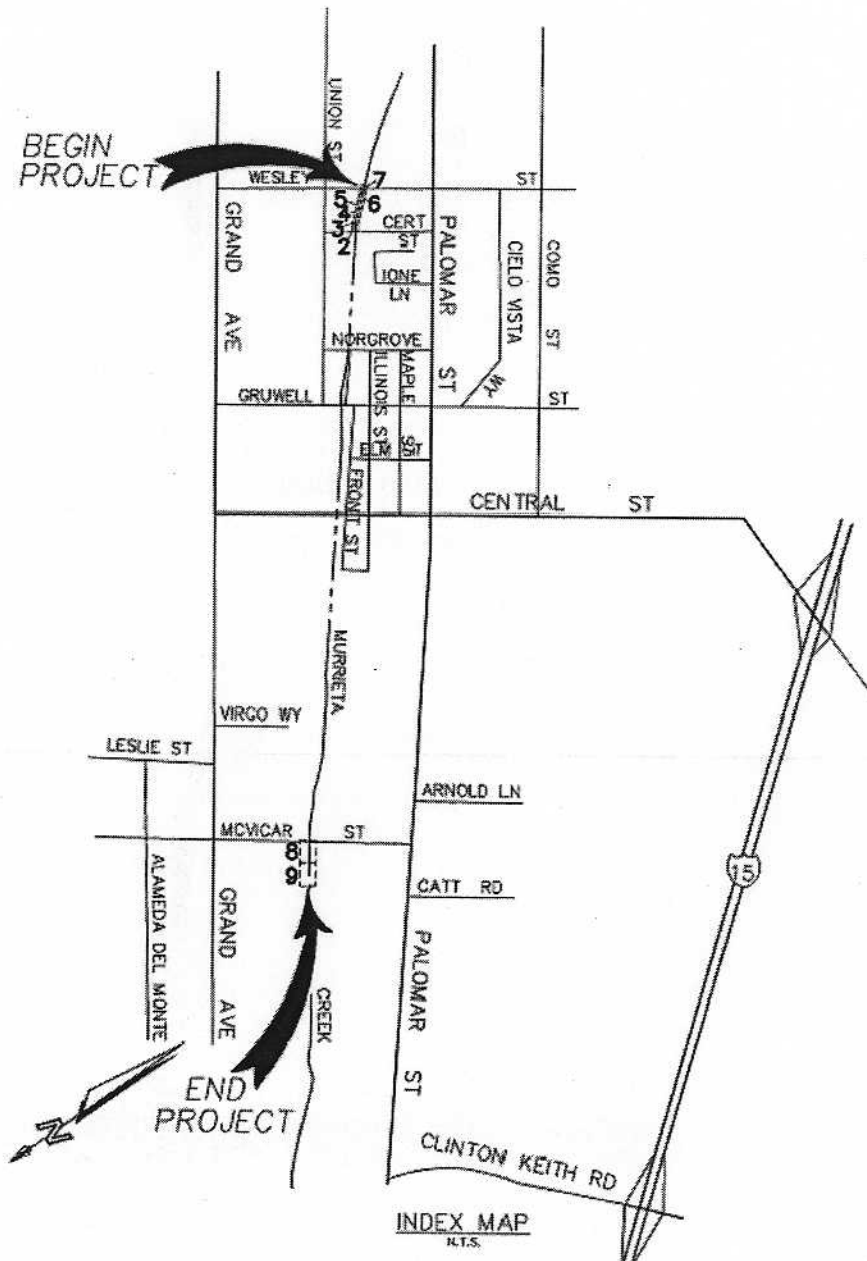

# WILDOMAR CHANNEL

## STAGE 5

7-0-0070



The Wildomar Channel, Stage 5 is located within the unincorporated Wildomar area of southwesterly Riverside County between Wesley Street and the northerly extension of Jane Court. The project consists of constructing approximately 2,200 feet long, 10 feet bottom width and 6.5 feet deep trapezoidal concrete channel, and 1,900 feet long, 11 feet wide mitigation area downstream of McVicar Street.
