Subject: Ratify the One-Year Extension Agreement with the City of Palm Desert
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BACKGROUND:

In August 2005, the Community Health Agency, Department of Animal Services responded to a Request for Proposal from the City of Palm Desert. The Department of Animal Services was awarded the contract in September 2005 to provide a broad range of animal control services for the purpose of safeguarding the City of Palm Desert's domestic and wild animals, promoting the humane treatment of animals and enforcing the City of Palm Desert's Ordinances and State laws relating to animal control. The contract was valid from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2006, with a one year extension through June 30, 2007 for which this Form 11 is referencing.

The Department has provided field and shelter services for the City of Palm Desert since July 1, 2003 and continues to provide these services to date even though the Fiscal Year 2006/07 contract had lapsed. The City of Palm Desert offered compelling evidence that the public safety would be jeopardized without the immediate rendering of services. The bulk of these services are provided by an Animal Control Officer fully funded by the City of Palm Desert pursuant to the original contract that was approved by the Board of Supervisors on November 25, 2003, item 3.9. Should the County not accept the extension, this position will be defunded.

This is a revenue contract in which the Department of Animal Services would be providing field services for the City of Palm Desert. The City of Palm Desert's animals are housed at the County shelter located at the Coachella Valley Animal Campus.
