SUBJECT: Joint Funding of Western Riverside Special Area Management Plan (SAMP) for the San Jacinto and Upper Santa Margarita Watersheds

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the Agreement for Joint Funding of Western Riverside Special Area Management Plan (SAMP) for the San Jacinto and Upper Santa Margarita Watersheds between Riverside County (County), Riverside County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (District), Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), and Western Riverside County Regional Conservation Authority (RCA) and;
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement documents on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND:

The attached Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for the completion and funding of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) development of a Special Area Management Plan (SAMP). The SAMP will establish Programmatic Regional General Permits and Letters of Permission that will address the impacts to ACOE jurisdictional areas located within the San Jacinto and Upper Santa Margarita watersheds.

FORM APPROVED COUNTY COUNSEL

The SAMP is to improve and facilitate the existing permitting process while protecting aquatic resources in the San Jacinto River and Upper Santa Margarita River Watersheds. The SAMP is being designed to further the objectives of the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan.

RCA is the lead contracting agency and is co-sharing project costs with the County, the District and RCTC. Jacobs Civil Inc. will provide technical support to RCA during the development and implementation of the SAMP. Riverside County's contribution to this effort is as follows; ACOE services \$133,000; Jacobs Civil Inc. \$16,210; for a total of \$149,210. The RCA, District and RCTC are each contributing \$149,210 to the project.
