**TO: BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

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**BACKGROUND:**

On February 1, 2006 Riverside County Purchasing and Fleet Services released Request for Proposals for the CAPIT Program (PUARC-802), PSSF Program (PUARC-803), and Differential Response (PUARC-805). The RFPs closed on March 1, 2006 with 44 proposals submitted from 29 organizations. As a result of the RFPs, 17 organizations were recommended to receive funding. On May 16, 2006, (Agenda #3.20), your Honorable Board approved the FY06/07 CAPIT & PSSF Funding Recommendations.

Based upon the current service levels, there is a need for additional funding to support anger management / domestic violence services in Western Riverside County. Upon further review of the clients receiving services, it was determined that many were referrals from Child Protective Services (CPS) with open/active cases. As a result, DPSS is able to utilize Child Welfare Services funding to provide these services.

Consequently, DPSS is seeking the Board's approval to allocate an additional \$150,000 for anger management / domestic violence services to ADV. These funds will be utilized by ADV to provide anger management services within the underserved communities located within the First, Second, Third and Fifth Supervisorial Districts. This funding will allow ADV to provide 7,696 additional units of anger management classes in Districts 1, 2, 3 and 5 to clients of the Children's Services Division that have open active CPS cases. Currently, Family Services of the Desert provide these services to District 4.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

\$5,173 of County Funds will be utilized for these services.
