BACKGROUND:

The College of the Desert Public Safety Academy will train future police and fire personnel. The total cost of the facility is \$29 million. A property tax bond was approved by the voters in 2004 to build the structure.

The College of the Desert Foundation is raising funds for student needs and instructional equipment at the Public Safety Academy. Each of the cities of the Coachella Valley and Blythe has been approached about contributing an amount comparable to the population of the city.

According to the Coachella Valley Association of Governments Technical Planning Subcommittee and the 2007 Regional Housing Needs Assessment, the population for the unincorporated area in 2005 was 70,069. The cost has been estimated at 50 cents per resident. The Fourth District acknowledges the tremendous benefit that the Public Safety Academy will provide and would like to use Community Improvement Funds.
