**SUBJECT:** "Contract for Extension of Electric Distribution Line" with the Southern California Edison Company, Limonite Avenue at Archibald Avenue, Eastvale area

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors approve the "Contract for Extension of Electric Distribution Line", which provides for the relocation of conflicting Edison Company owned facilities to an underground location and provides for electrical energy for the traffic signal modifications under construction at Limonite Avenue and Archibald Avenue, and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement on behalf of the County of Riverside.

**BACKGROUND:** By Board action dated May 2, 2006 (agenda item 3.41) the Board of Supervisors awarded the contract to construct roadway widening, traffic signal and storm drain improvements on Limonite Avenue between Archibald Avenue and Hamner Avenue. That project includes roadway, storm drain and traffic signal improvements at the intersection of Limonite Avenue and Archibald Avenue, which requires the removal of utility poles which are in conflict with the project improvements.

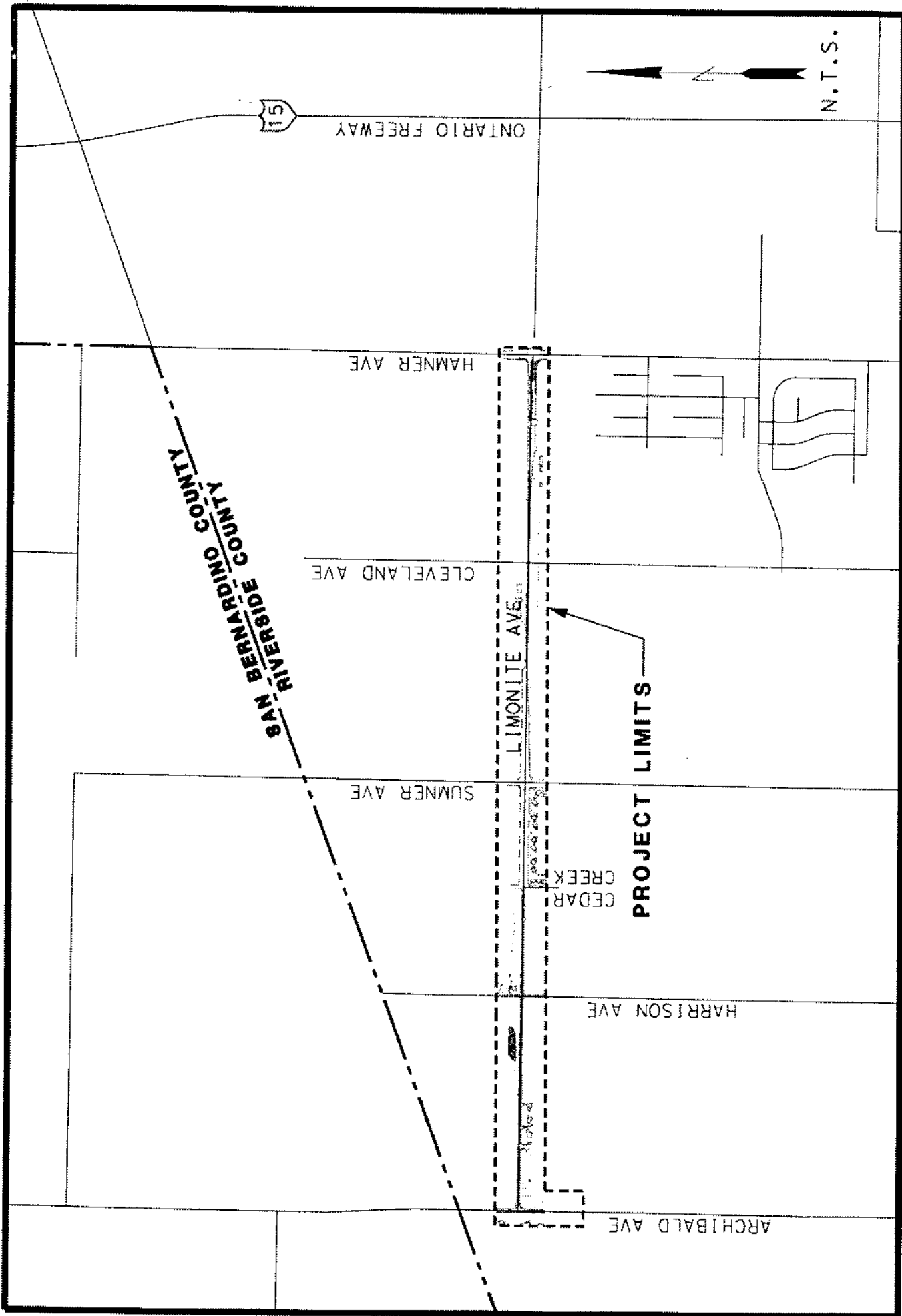
Execution of the "Contract for Extension of Electric Distribution Line" provides for the construction of the underground line extension, which will remove the conflicting utility poles and replace the aerial facilities with underground electrical facilities, which has been determined to be appropriate for this project. The undergrounding of the aerial also facilitates the construction of a separate undergrounding project of the Edison Company, and provides for future use by adjacent land developers. Billing credit has been given for costs that are the Edison Company's responsibility.

Funding for the line extension is available from the project budget, and is being supplemented by developer contributions, under a separate arrangement.

Execution of this agreement by the Board of Supervisors is necessary because the agreement amount exceeds the authority that was previously granted to the Director of Transportation.

Construction of the Limonite Avenue improvements has experienced significant delays due to challenges associated with the undergrounding and relocation of Edison Company and Verizon Communications facilities. The Transportation Department is working closely with both companies and anticipates that construction will commence in April, 2007.
