SUBJECT: Limonite Underpass Beautification Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors make the following findings:

1. The proposed Limonite underpass improvements are of benefit to the Jurupa Valley Redevelopment Project Area because they will help to beautify this corridor and assist in the elimination of blight within the project area;
2. No other reasonable means of financing the project is available to the community due to limited funds which are insufficient to provide the beautification improvements;
3. The proposed project will assist with the elimination of blighting conditions within the Project Area by providing new landscaping and decorative concrete on existing slopes that are currently an eyesore; and
4. Street improvements are identified as eligible projects in the Implementation Plan for the Project Area.

BACKGROUND: Since 1996, the Redevelopment Agency ("Agency") has initiated revitalization efforts for the unincorporated communities of the Jurupa Valley. A key feature of this plan has been the elimination of blighting conditions within the project area by improving landscaping and adding beautification features.

The Limonite Underpass at Van Buren Boulevard currently consists of concrete slope embankments with minor areas of landscaping. The proposed project will enhance the underpass by providing a patriotic-themed, masonry veneer to the existing concrete surfaced embankments and new landscaping to enhance and soften the existing hardscape features.

As the lead agency, the project has been reviewed by staff, and it has been determined that the project will not have a significant impact on the environment according to the guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Article 19, Section 15301 (c), the project is categorically exempt from CEQA review.

Agency staff recommends that the Board make the required findings. There is a companion item that appears on today's Board of Directors Agenda.
