SUBJECT: TUMF Funding Agreement between County of Riverside Transportation Department (County) and Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) for the Reche Vista Drive/Reche Canyon Road Project (RCTC Agreement No. 07-72-068-00)

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board approve the attached TUMF Funding Agreement between the County and RCTC, and authorize the Chairman to execute same.

BACKGROUND: Reche Vista Drive and Reche Canyon Road will be improved to four lanes from Heacock Street to San Bernardino County Line. Improvements north of the County line are likely to be completed concurrently with this project. Currently, SANBAG, RCTC, County of Riverside, County of San Bernardino and Cities of Colton, Grand Terrace, Loma Linda, Moreno Valley, Redlands, Riverside and San Bernardino are cooperatively participating in a Memorandum of Understanding on Improvement of Transportation Facilities, which includes Reche Vista Drive, Reche Canyon Road, and Pigeon Pass corridors.

The portion eligible for TUMF funding includes the segments within the jurisdiction of Riverside County and City of Moreno Valley. Improvements for Reche Canyon Road in San Bernardino County and the City of Colton will be funded by abutting developments or other funds.

By this Agreement, RCTC intends to distribute TUMF Regional Funds to the County for the subject project, which initiates the planning process, and includes alignment studies, preliminary engineering, environmental studies and environmental documentation.
