That the Board of Supervisors:


- 1) Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation funds for the KMIR'S Teen Driving Clinic; and

**BACKGROUND:**

The percentage of teenage drivers killed in their first couple of years of driving continues to rise. In fact, since 2000, the fatality rate has doubled in the Coachella Valley. It is reported that 65% of teen passenger deaths occur when the driver is a teenager. KMIR is in their second year of hosting a teen driving clinic, which focuses on driver education and training, behind the wheel experience, defensive driving skills, accident avoidance maneuvers, brake management, steering management, and eye management. The cost is \$149 dollars per family.
