**SUBJECT:** Engineering and Environmental Services Agreement for the Limonite Avenue / Interstate 15 Interchange Project.

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

That the Board approve the attached Engineering and Environmental Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Dokken Engineering, and authorize the Chairman to execute same.

**BACKGROUND:** Limonite Avenue serves the Jurupa and Eastvale areas as one of the key regional east-west arterials. This project will replace the existing bridge overcrossing with a new wider structure over Interstate 15 at Limonite Avenue. The existing facility is a low capacity diamond interchange typical of rural areas constructed in the early 1980's. A Project Study Report has been prepared for this project and is currently in the agency review process. Also, the County will soon begin construction to widen the segment of Limonite Avenue from Archibald Avenue to Hamner Avenue. In addition, the County is proposing to widen the segments of Limonite Avenue from Hamner Avenue to Etiwanda Avenue, and from Etiwanda Avenue to Van Buren Boulevard under separate projects. Together these projects will eliminate the missing link and create a continuous four-lane roadway with six lanes at the interchange.

Dokken Engineering is on the Transportation Department's Pre-Qualified List of Highway Design firms. The list was established through a request for proposals, which was advertised in the Press Enterprise and the Desert Sun. Eighteen firms submitted qualifications. Representatives from Caltrans, and the Riverside County Transportation Department evaluated the written proposals and interviewed the nine top ranked firms.

Dokken Engineering was selected as the firm to provide the needed services for the Limonite Avenue/I-15 project, and a not to exceed budget of \$2,791,368 (including contingency) was negotiated between Dokken and the Riverside County Transportation Department. The project scope includes preparation of a Project Report; environmental document; final Plans Specifications and Estimates (PS&E); and construction support services.
