SUBJECT: Approval of the Sheriff's Participation in a Multi-Agency Agreement For Policing of Off-Highway Vehicle Activity

RECOMMENDED MOTION: Move that the Board of Supervisors approve a multi-agency cooperative Agreement to address illegal off-highway vehicle (OHV) activity in the Coachella Valley, and authorize the Sheriff to sign all copies.

BACKGROUND: The Coachella Valley Association of Governments' (CVAG) OHV Task Force, comprised of the cities of Cathedral City, Desert Hot Springs, and Indio, the Federal Bureau of Land Management, the Sheriff's Department and the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians, has identified areas in the Valley where illegal off-highway vehicle activity is a problem. CVAG has been awarded \$80,000 in grant funds from the Colmac Air Quality Enhancement Fund to defray the costs of off-highway vehicle enforcement efforts in the Valley and to mount a public awareness and education campaign on the dangers of off-highway riding and the environmental destruction it causes.

The present Agreement outlines the cooperative agency effort, patrol parameters and grant funding distribution guidelines. The Agreement term will expire on March 26, 2008. County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.
