**SUBJECT:** Agreement to Participate in a Fecal Indicator Bacteria Study in the Santa Ana River Watershed

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:**

1. Approve the Agreement between the District and the National Water Research Institute (NWRI); and
2. Authorize the Chairman to execute the Agreement on behalf of the District.

**BACKGROUND:**

The District, the County of Riverside, and the cities of Riverside County are required in their National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Municipal Stormwater Permit, Board Order R8-2002-0011, CAS618033, to participate in a bacterial source assessment monitoring program for the Santa Ana River. Participation in this study will comply with the Permit requirement.

The Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions by which the University of California, Irvine (UCI) will perform tasks in coordination with the NWRI. UCI will determine the source and magnitude of fecal indicator bacteria at several stations in the Santa Ana River Watershed under dry weather low flow conditions.
