SUBJECT: PURCHASE FIBER BRONCHOSCOPES WITHOUT SECURING COMPETITIVE BIDS

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

Receives and files notice of the proposed purchase of three (3) Fiber Bronchoscopes, without seeking competition, in accordance with Ordinance No. 459.4, in the amount of \$36,351.08, to Pentax, pursuant to the Purchasing Agent approving this purchase on behalf of the County.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC) is currently utilizing Pentax Bronchoscopes throughout the hospital, which were acquired through the competitive bidding process. The latest bid was completed in September 2005. Bronchoscopes are used for the diagnostic process and disease treatment during lung procedures. As patient census continues to rise and more procedures are performed, additional Bronchoscopes are needed. RCRMC is seeking to purchase three (3) Pentax Bronchoscopes to ensure equipment compatibility and safe patient care through standardization.

Supply/Service being requested: Fiber Bronchoscopes

Supplier being requested: Pentax

Alternative suppliers that can or might be able to provide supply/service: Olympus, Karl Storz, Millenium Surgical

Extent of market search conducted: Internet search

Unique features of the supply/service being requested from this supplier, which no alternative supplier can provide: Matches existing Bronchoscopes used hospital wide and historically has been the least expensive when bid. The latest bid was completed in September 2005.

Reasons why my department requires these unique features and what benefit will accrue to the county: Standardization and familiarity of instrumentation.
