**BACKGROUND:** This agreement allows for Department of Animal Services Community Outreach and Education staff to plan and conduct a one-week Humane Education Program for children ages 7-11 for the periods July 16-20 and August 13-17, 2007. This would establish the opportunity for further collaboration as the Department of Animal Services Community Outreach and Education Division develops education programs for children residing in Riverside County.
