

SUBJECT: Amendment to Agreement with California Department of Health Services (CDHS) Covering Fiscal Years 2007-08 and 2008-09 for Contracted County Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) Allowable for Federal Financial Participation (FFP).

BACKGROUND:

This Agreement/Contract Amendment continues to allow the County to receive FFP for Medi-Cal Administrative Activities, via the State's Administrative Plan for eligible clients. The Community Health Agency is acting as the single County Agency through which claims will be made under this Agreement. The Agency is anticipating annual funding of \$340,000 from this contract. A budget adjustment is not required in the Agency Budget. Additionally, annual MAA funds of \$300,000 are distributed to the Public Guardian and Riverside County Regional Medical Center (RCRMC), who are also participating in the program. Riverside County school districts also participate in the MAA program and receive annual funding of \$6,700,000.
