BACKGROUND: On June 27, 2006, agenda item 3.32, the Board approved a contract for fiscal year 2006/07 with V.I.P. Tots for children services in the Mid-County region. V.I.P. Tots provided services to Prop. 10 beneficiaries as a subcontractor to the Riverside County Department of Mental Health (RCDMH).

SUBJECT: Ratify the Subcontract Agreement between V.I.P. Tots and Riverside County Department of Mental Health, Mid-County Region's Children's Services

BACKGROUND: (Continued)

After the contract was approved, First 5 notified the department that Prop. 10 funds would only be for a six month period. Prop. 10 then issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for alternative Prop. 10 services. The scope of work as outlined in the RFP was not focused on mental health services, therefore the department did not respond directly.

VIP Tots submitted their proposal to First 5 naming RCDMH as a subcontractor for mental health services. The proposal from V.I.P. Tots was accepted and V.I.P. Tots was awarded funding. Mental health services the Department is providing include: Parent Education, Family Literacy program and Child Care Access and Linkage Program.

There are sufficient funds in the Department's budget to provide these services. No additional County Funds are required.

PERFORMANCE PERIOD:

The performance period is January 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008.

JUSTIFICATION FOR DELAY:

The agreement was received from V.I.P. Tots in February 2007. The department's fiscal management team conducted a thorough review of the reimbursement for the services provided. It was determined that the reimbursement was appropriate and then approved the reimbursement methodology in April 2007. The agreement is now ready for Board approval.
