BACKGROUND:

The "WE CARE" Free Mobile Mammography Program is a grassroots effort to ensure that the uninsured and underinsured women of the Coachella Valley have life-saving preventive mammogram screenings.

Free clinics will be held at the Temple Isiah in Palm Springs, the Eleanor Shadowden Senior Center in Coachella, and the Desert Aids Project in Pam Springs. The goal is to screen 400 women, up from 37 women screened in 2006.

The "WE CARE" program is supported by The Desert Women for Equality's fundraising efforts, grants from the Bob Hope Chrysler Classic, the City of Palm Springs, the Theresa Holden Foundation, and the Desert Business Association, and donations from community members.

We would like to use Fourth District Community Improvement funds to provide additional mammograms to women that would otherwise not have the exam due to financial constraints.
