SUBJECT: Fifth District Use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens


RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve the use of Community Improvement Designation Funds for renovations of restroom facilities at the Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens; and
2. Direct the Auditor-Controller to adjust appropriations, estimated revenue and designations as follows:

BACKGROUND: The Edward-Dean Museum & Gardens is a County museum and cultural resource. A renovation of the main public restrooms will improve the facility and further the ability to market the campus as an event destination and generate revenue from its facility rental program.
