BACKGROUND:

The Precious Blood Preschool is a daycare center serving the residents of Banning. They have applied for various grants and funds to double their capacity which requires renovation and expansion of the existing facility.

The Eagle's Wings Community Center is located in the city of Perris where it currently provides community outreach programs. They are currently raising funds to pave the parking lot so they may move forward with a child care center and additional programs.

Nuevo Citizen's Patrol is a volunteer unit that provides valuable support to the Riverside County Sheriff's Department. They are currently raising funds through local donations for bake sales, and car washes to support vehicle maintenance, volunteer training and First Aid Kits.

The California Riverside Ballet is a non-profit organization that participates in an Education and Community Outreach Program that allows over 8,000 children a year throughout the county to attend performances.

I urge Board approval of these uses of Community Improvement Designation funds.
