**BACKGROUND:**

The Unforgettables Foundation is a non-profit organization that provides burial assistance for grieving families who have had a child die. Last year they provided assistance to over 400 families.

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) provides advocacy for children throughout Riverside County. Specifically, it provides vital services with 22% of all children in the dependency system and 35% of the children placed within the five districts of the County, placed in Fifth District, more than double the average of the other districts.

Kids Enterprise is a non-profit organization in Moreno Valley that prints a quarterly magazine that is compiled entirely by students who interview, write, edit, post pictures and print the magazine. Funded with CDBG funds from the County and the City of Moreno Valley, these funds will be utilized as working capital to purchase ink and replacement equipment for the printers that produce the magazine

I urge Board approval of these uses of 5<sup>th</sup> District Community Improvement Designation funds.
