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
BACKGROUND:

San Gorgonio Memorial Hospital provides medical services throughout the pass area which includes Beaumont, Banning, Calimesa, and Cabazon. The purpose of these funds are to purchase and install a view fluoroscope, an integral diagnostic imaging tool utilized during specialized x-ray examinations.

Beaumont Unified School District is a partner with the City of Beaumont in the Community Joint Use Aquatic Center Facility which will provide a competition size pool for the entire community. These funds will assist in the construction costs for a restroom and changing room in addition to a masonry pool equipment building to house the pool equipment.

PassCom is the Pass Area Emergency Planning Committee that seeks to educate, train and equip the residents of Calimesa's seven mobile home parks in emergency preparedness and response.

I urge Board approval of these uses of 5th District Community Improvement Designation funds.
