SUBJECT: Agreements for Domestic Crisis and Referral Services with Alternatives to Domestic Violence and Shelter from the Storm

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board:

- 1) Approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the attached agreements for Domestic Crisis and Referral Services with Alternatives to Domestic Violence and with Shelter from the Storm, three years, renewable in one year increments; and,
- 2) Approve, and authorize the Chairman to sign, the attached agreement for Domestic Crisis and Referral Services in Southwest County with Alternatives to Domestic Violence for three years, renewable in one year increments.

BACKGROUND: State statutes allow a surcharge on marriage license fees in the amount of \$23.00 to be collected and allocated to approved organizations assisting victims of domestic violence. These are commonly referred to as Presley Funds. These services are provided in the eastern part of the county by Shelter from the Storm and in the western part of the county by Alternatives to Domestic Violence. Presley Funds generate approximately \$220,000 annually, with each agency receiving one-half the available funding in an amount not to exceed \$110,000 annually. (Continued)

Conditions of probation for domestic violence crimes include a \$200 fee of which \$66.67 is collected by the County and deposited into a trust fund for domestic violence programs. This trust fund is separate from the Presley Fund and generates approximately \$110,000 annually. These referral services are provided in the Southwest County by Alternatives to Domestic Violence.
